

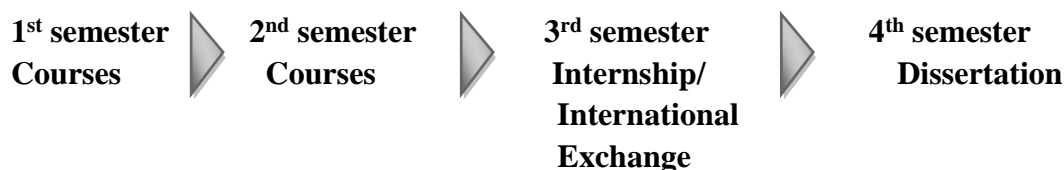
## Master of China's Politics and Economy

### ■ Program Overview

The two-year China's Politics and Economy MA (CPE) program, started from 2012, is geared towards students seeking to enrich their understanding of contemporary China. Students in the program develop the ability to analyze China's domestic and foreign politics, economy, and society from both comparative and international theoretical and policy perspectives. CPE students not only acquire tremendous conceptual and factual knowledge, but also develop the functional skills needed to pursue China-related careers in business, government, and non-governmental organizations.

In the last four years, the CPE program welcomed 75 students from 29 different countries (primarily Europe and the US) with diverse educational and work backgrounds. As part of the CPE program, these students had the opportunity to attend many international meetings and symposiums pertaining to China as well as to hear from leading global experts and politicians on a variety of China-related topics. School also establishes cooperate unites with various domestic and international companies, research institutes and government departments.
