

## Master of Foreign Languages and Literature

### ■ Program Overview

Master of Foreign Languages and Literature is a full-time program offered by School of Foreign Languages, Shanghai Jiao Tong University. MA candidate is supposed to spend two and a half years on campus before he or she obtains the minimum credits of 28, with 18 compulsory courses credits (12 calculated into GPA). The courses are required to be completed in 1.5 years. At least one research paper should be published before the candidate applies for the Master Degree. In this paper, the candidate himself or herself should be the first author. Publications on CSSCI, SSCI, A&HCI, SCI, EI magazines are encouraged. Main research fields in this program include Linguistics and Applied Linguistics, English Language and Literature. The obtainer of the MA degree for the subject is expected to systematically and profoundly grasp the knowledge concerned with the subject and be well-informed of the status quo, developments and international frontiers of the field. He/She is enabled to engage in the researches of rather high theoretical and practical significance, where he/she can display originality and make achievements. He/She can master a foreign language and have a rather fluent grasp of a second foreign language.
